Class Policies

Be prepared for class every day:

Students are expected to be aware of the daily class schedule and to have all materials in class when needed.

Lockers:

Each student will be issued a locker. Students will visit their locker in the morning, at lunchtime, and at the end of the day only. Locks are not permitted, so we ask students not to store valuables in their locker.

Policies, Continued...

Late/Missing Work:

Work is expected to be in class and complete when it is due!

If a student is absent, work will be collected for him/her. It is the student's responsibility to ask for further clarification on the lessons taught while away from school and to complete all missed work in a timely manner.

Friday Folders:

Most graded work is sent home each Friday in what's called a Friday Folder. Parents are asked to review this information and return the folder the next school day.

Planners:

Fifth grade is a significant milestone in your child's development as a successful student. Effective study skills and organization are vital in this development. To assist in this process, we use the daily planner book on our team.

Students are expected to record the day's assignments in their planners every afternoon. Any completed work should be checked off. Parents are asked to review the assignment book as it is our way of communicating assignments and announcements. We encourage parents to be curious...ask to see completed work at home. This is a good opportunity to review the day's lesson and to be involved in your child's learning.

Materials List

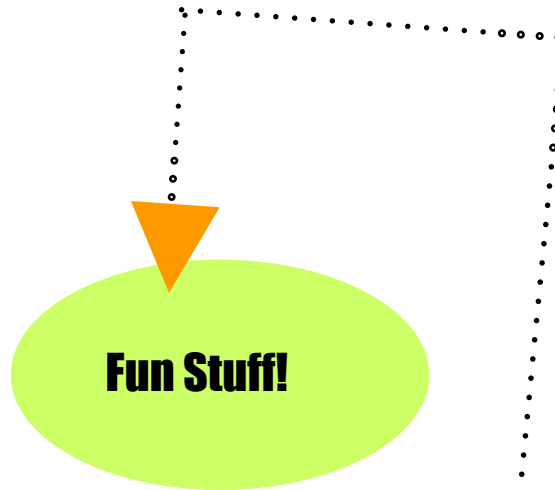
All team 57 students need the following materials:
