We believe that all students can make the proper choice to follow these expectations. When students make the correct choice, their leadership and the learning of others will not be disrupted, but will grow.

### Positive & Negative Consequences: Card System

When a poor choice is made, students will pull a card to remind them to follow the rules of the class and school. Cards are reset **EVERY** day to allow students to have a “fresh-start”. For each card pulled, 10 minutes will be deducted from our Reward Day, given quarterly. Mrs. Hepler and Mrs. McKeown also have positive rewards as part of their classroom management.

1st card = warning

2nd card= 10 minutes deducted from reward activity

3rd card= 10 minutes deducted from reward activity

4th card= 10 minutes deducted from reward activity & writing assignment

### Assignment Book/Friday Folders/Independent Reading

Students are expected to use the Assignment Book provided by the school DAILY. Assignments will be written down by the teacher for students to copy. Parent signatures are not necessary unless the need arises.

**Friday folders go home every Friday with important papers and information and are to be returned every Monday. Please sign the Signature Sheet and return with the folder.**

It is required that all students read independently daily at Lakeview. Please see that Reading is part of your child's daily activities. More information regarding a Reading incentive program will be coming home.

Communication

Please be sure to share your email address with us, so that you will receive updates regarding curriculum and school activities.

Progress Book is a great tool to know what/how your child is doing at school. Please check it weekly for assignments, grades, and special notifications. Your child should be checking Progress Book daily as well. Please look beyond the initial screen for comments on assignments.
