## **Class Policies**

#### Be prepared for class every day:

Students are expected to be aware of the daily class schedule and to have all materials in class when needed.

#### Lockers:

Each student will be issued a locker. They may visit their locker in the morning, at lunchtime, and at the end of the day <u>only</u>. Locks are not permitted, so we ask students not to store valuables in their locker.

## **Policies, Continued...**

#### Late/Missing Work:

Work is expected to be in class and complete when it is due. No extensions will be made for lost or late work. Students will receive zero credit for late or missing assignments.

If a student is absent, work will be collected for him/her. It is the student's responsibility to ask for further clarification on the lessons taught while away from school and to complete all missed work in a timely manner.

#### Friday Folders:

Most graded work is sent home each Friday.

Parents are asked to review this information, sign the folder, and return it the next school day.

#### Assignment Books:

Fifth grade is a significant milestone in your child's development as a successful student. Effective study skills are vital in this development. To assist in this process, we use the building assignment book on our team.

Students are expected to record the day's assignments in their assignment books every afternoon. As they complete work, they should check it off. Parents are asked to review the assignment book and initial it nightly. We encourage parents to be curious...ask to see completed work at home. This is a good opportunity to review the day's lesson and to be involved in your child's learning.

All team 57 students need the following materials:


- A two inch binder/trapper to organize papers throughout the year
