Dear Parents, Students are expected to have the following supplies. Please label all items with your child's name, as items can be easily misplaced. Please, also note, that some items will need to be replenished throughout the year.

For all Team 8 Students:

- **1 expandable, 8 sections, (be sure it will fit in a backpack, please label the tabs in this order: homework, math, science, social studies, reading, writing, paper)**
- **1 soft-sided lunch bag with handle and zipper to be used for art supplies**
- **2 packages loose leaf wide-ruled notebook paper** (1 to start year and 1 for home)
- **2: 1 subject, wide ruled spiral notebooks**(Please label, one “math” & the other, “science”)
- **1: 3 subject notebook (wide ruled)**
- **Clipboard for personal use** (gently used or new)
- **Earbuds/headphones** (inexpensive- to be kept at school, ziploc bags are great for storage)
- **2 boxes of Kleenex**
- **deodorant** (to be kept in locker and used as needed)
- **#2 pencils** (at least 6, sharpened to start the year. Stock up as supplies need replenished)
- **2 red pens**
- **Ruler with inches, cm and mm**
- **Erasers** (functional, not toy-like)
- **2 highlighters, 1 yellow and 1 orange**
- **2 permanent markers**
- **1 bottle white glue, like Elmers**
- **Scissors**
- **Markers**
- **Crayons** (24 count or smaller)
- **Colored Pencils**
- **Paint t-shirt** for art- labeled with name
- **1 package sticky notes** (2 inch square)
- Water bottles are welcome and are to be used for water only (wrapped in an old “tube” sock)
- Girls: wipes (like Clorox)
- Boys: hand sanitizer (like Purell)
