

Annual Notification to Parents

In accordance with the No Child Left Behind act, school districts are required to develop policies and procedures and to notify families on an annual basis regarding:

- The right of parents to inspect surveys before they are administered by the school to their child
- Efforts to protect student privacy in the event a survey is distributed to students
- The right of parents to inspect instructional materials (excluding tests) that are part of their child's curriculum
- The administration of student physical examinations or screenings
- The collection, disclosure or use of students' personal information
- The right of parents to inspect any instrument used in the collection of their child's personal information

Parents also have the right to opt their child out of participation in certain activities such as surveys and physical examinations and screenings.
